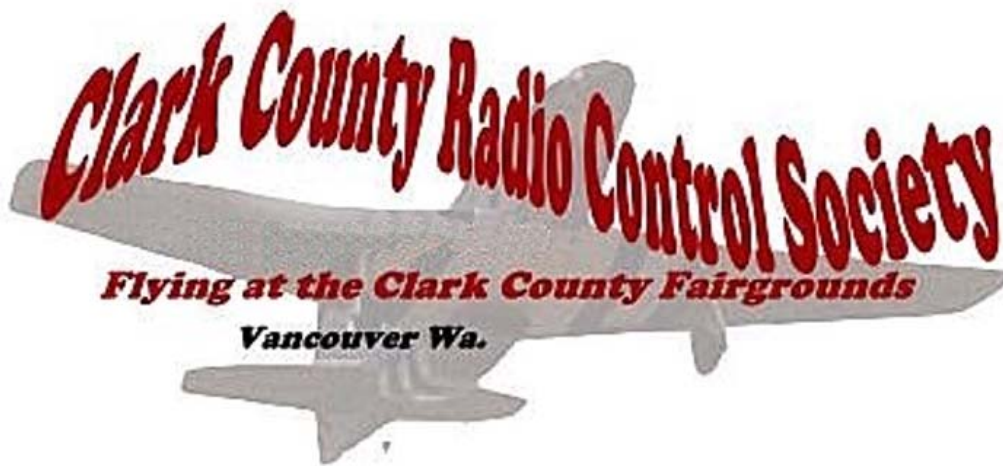

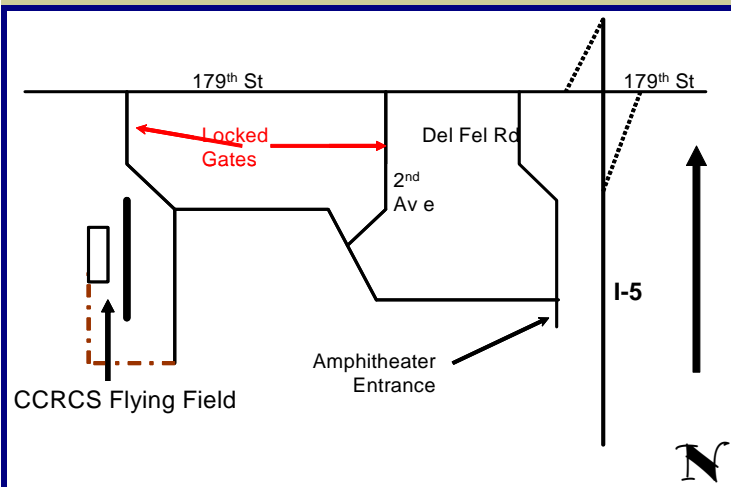

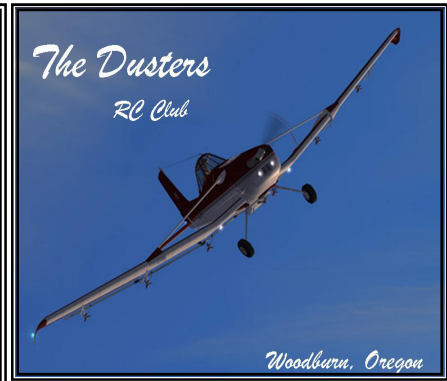
Saturday, June 20th

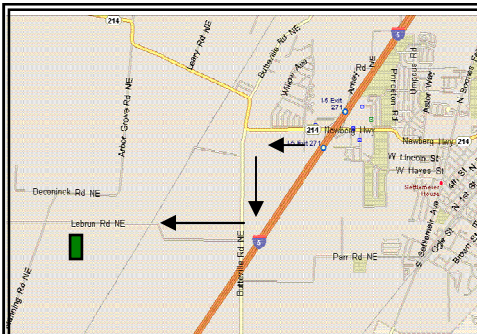

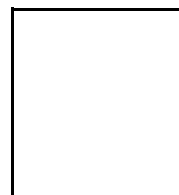
